



NEWS: MAFAC Launches **Survey** to Assess Climate Information Needs of Stakeholders

(October 26, 2016) Curious about how climate change may impact fisheries and fishing communities? The Marine Fisheries Advisory Committee (MAFAC) is conducting a short **survey**, and feedback from fisheries stakeholders and others is important!

The purpose of this **survey** is to help the MAFAC learn more about the information resources fishery stakeholders need regarding changing environmental conditions and the effects on fisheries, aquaculture, and coastal communities. The **survey** is voluntary, includes 14 questions, and will take about 10 minutes to complete. It will gather information on the types of information resources needed and used, the leaders and sources that are trusted, and which information formats are most useful.

The survey responses will help MAFAC formulate recommendations for NOAA regarding these topics and the best ways for NOAA to share and communicate climate information to stakeholders.
