WAN CHANGE CONTROL

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SUMMARY OF REVISIONS:

Purpose

Circular A-130, Appendix III, Security of Federal Automated Information Resources and the Federal Information Security Management Act (FISMA, enacted December 2002), require agencies to adhere to computer security practices. This directive identifies the responsibilities for implementing changes to the Wide Area Networks that support the NOAA Fisheries Services Information Technology (IT) operations. Procedural directives will be issued to implement this policy as needed.

Authorities and Responsibilities

This directive establishes the following authorities and responsibilities:

- The Chief Information Officer (CIO) for Fisheries will have agency-wide oversight of the NOAA Fisheries Services Network operations and management.
- IT Support Staff. The CIO is assisted in administering the agency's WAN by the Network Manager, Regional Information Technology Coordinators (RITCs), the Office Information Technology Coordinators (OITCs), IT Security Officer (ITSO), and Network and System Administrators.
