A culvert on Merrill Creek, a tributary of the Salmon River in the Klamath River basin was replaced with a bridge in September 2002 by the Siskiyou County Department of Public Works using funds from the State of California and the Pacific Coastal Salmon Recovery Fund. This project replaced a metal culvert on a county road with a bridge to open up 3 miles of prime coho salmon and steelhead habitat that had been blocked.
