

SUPPLEMENTAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR SF-424C

Use this form and not the SF-424A if a significant amount (equal to or greater than 50%) of the Federal funds requested are for construction projects (e.g., build-outs, alterations, upgrades and renovations of existing facilities)

BUDGET INFORMATION

Cost Classification

Line 1-16, column(a): Total estimated costs for proposed project by category.

Line 1-16, column(b): Amount of total proposed costs that are not allowable. For the Prescott Program, Line 13: "Contingencies" is not allowable. All other categories designated as allowable, must be clearly explained and itemized per NOAA/NMFS Budget Justification Guidelines.

Line 15: Program Income - Although we do not anticipate income generation from Prescott Program projects, if there will be income, identify the estimated amount and ensure appropriate narrative justification.

FEDERAL FUNDING

Note: The Prescott Program cannot accept proposals exceeding \$100,000 in Federal funds. The Prescott Grant Program requires non-Federal match of 25% or more of the Total project costs; therefore, the Federal match should be equal to or less than 75% of the Total project costs.

Line 17: In the _____ %, enter 75 or below. (Please note that if the proposal is recommended for funding, this percentage cannot be changed once the award is finalized by a NOAA Grants Official.)

Line 17, column (c): For the Prescott Grant Program, this amount cannot exceed \$100,000. Amount derived from multiplying the amount in Line 16, column (c) by _____ %.

Examples:

If Line 16, column (c) = \$130,350.00 and Line 17 = 75%,
Then the Federal Share = $\$130,350.00 \times 0.75 = \$97,762.50$

If Line 16, column (c) = \$256,600.00 and Line 17 = 38%,
Then the Federal Share = $\$256,600.00 \times 0.38 = \$97,508.00$
