Sunflower Sea Star Distribution

Sunflower sea stars are native to marine waters along the Pacific Coast, from northern Baja California to the central Aleutian Islands. Although they can live in waters ranging from a few feet deep to greater than 1,400 ft. deep,

sunflower sea stars are generally encountered in waters shallower than 120 ft. deep.
