



**Figure A1. Albacore - North Atlantic**

**Figure A3. Barndoor skate – Georges Bank / Southern New England**






Figure A4. Bocaccio – Pacific Coast




**Figure A5. Butterfish - Gulf of Maine / Cape Hatteras**




The stock assessment in 2004 found this stock to be overfished, but the 2009 assessment was rejected and the status of butterfish was officially listed as unknown. It remained in a rebuilding plan due to uncertainty about the stock status. The 2014 stock assessment found that the biomass estimates from the 2004 assessment were considerably higher than previously estimated. This assessment used a new model, which was determined to be more reliable than previous assessments.

**Figure A6. Canary Rockfish – Pacific Coast**




Overfishing determination is made on the basis of catch data, but F estimates were used to determine what the estimated fishing mortality was in each year for this trends analysis.


Figure A7. Cowcod – Pacific Coast




Figure A11. Petrale sole – Pacific Coast




Figure A12. Red Porgy – Southern Atlantic Coast





Figure A13. Red Snapper – Gulf of Mexico



**Figure A14. Smooth skate – Gulf of Maine**




Figure A15. Golden Tilefish – Mid-Atlantic Coast




Figure A16. White Hake – Gulf of Maine / Georges Bank




Figure A17. Winter Flounder – Georges Bank




Figure A18. Yelloweye Rockfish – Pacific Coast
