

NMFS ANNOUNCES THAT THE ATLANTIC SHARK IDENTIFICATION WORKSHOP THAT WAS TO BE HELD IN WILMINGTON, NC ON SEPTEMBER 2, 2010, HAS BEEN RESCHEDULED TO SEPTEMBER 9, 2010

The National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) requires that Atlantic Shark Dealer permit holders attend and become certified at Atlantic Shark Identification Workshops (71 FR 58057; October 2, 2006). These workshops are conducted monthly at various locations along the Atlantic coast and Gulf of Mexico. The dates and locations of the workshops are announced quarterly through publication of a notice in the Federal Register, letters to affected permit holders, and an e-mail notice to subscribers of "Atlantic HMS News."
